The Fund will award one **scholarship** to a person age 13 through 30. There is a critical shortage of trained organists. We wish to encourage and support the training of talented young pianists to serve as church organists.

Qualifications The Student must

- Display appropriate motivation for church organ performance.
- Obtain approval from current piano/organ instructor.
- Have played a solo or duet for an audience at a scheduled event within 1.5 years.
- Be age 13 through 30.
- Reside in Oregon or southwest Washington.
- Membership in St. Andrew Lutheran Church is not required, but St. Andrew members are encouraged to apply.

Benefits The Fund will pay \$400 each semester (Summer or Fall, and Spring) towards organ lessons with a recognized organ teacher. The St. Andrew Lutheran Church organ is available to the award recipient for practice and lessons. A student may re-apply to renew the scholarship after successful completion of one year of lessons.

Responsibilities The scholarship recipient (and parent/guardian if the student is not yet 18) must sign and abide by an agreement to

- Practice faithfully and attend lessons regularly
- Promptly purchase organ playing shoes and music
- Pay any remaining amount of normal lesson fees
- Play an appropriate organ prelude, postlude, offertory, hymn, **or** liturgy at the usual services of St. Andrew Lutheran Church for one Sunday
