Earning All In Points

A big part of the Confirmation class experience is discovering ways for you to become a part of the St. Andrew community. A good way to do this is to try your hand at various roles. To make this more interesting, you will earn All In points for doing this. Each week, you will update the class chart to include any points since your last update. There are opportunities to earn points both during and outside of worship services. Different levels of points are available, depending on the amount of commitment required:

Five Points		
Fill out Worship Notes	Help with communion	
Attend worship	Attend class	
Help with coffee service and cleanup	Attend a congregation event (meeting, special event)	

Ten Points	
Be a Greeter	Help with a church-wide event or service project
Be an acolyte (including helping with communion)	Be a lector (read the scripture lessons during worship and help with communion)
Be an usher	Help in the nursery
Attend a middle school fellowship event	Join the singing or bell choir: 10 points per month of faithful attendance at rehearsals and performances. NOTE: Speak with Deacon Susan Reiser

Twenty Points	
Participate in the Bible Bowl	Participate in an overnight retreat
Help plan and lead our worship service	Provide special music for worship

Your goal is to earn at least 200 points (Silver Level) by the middle of May.

Rewards:

There are rewards available at different levels of participation:

For every 20 points, receive a small piece of candy during class. For every 100 points, receive a full-sized candy bar or bag of candy.

And for those who reach for the stars:

Everyone who reaches Gold Level-400 points-will be invited to a trip to Oaks Park with Kyler in May or June.

Does earning 200 points sound impossible? Note:

- If you attend 25 out of the possible 27 classes and attend worship before class, that's 100 points.
- ❖ If you participate in the Bible Bowl, a retreat, and the Confirmation class-led worship service, that's another 60 points.
- You can easily earn 40 more points by trying out the various activities listed above.

Earning 400 points does require more effort, but it is absolutely attainable.

If you have another idea for earning points, check with one of the Confirmation teachers. If it involves being a part of a ministry at St. Andrew, chances are good that you can earn points for it.
